1829 MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS

1831 VISITOR

The South Staffordshire District Council's Village Agent, Jan Wright attended the meeting to let the Parish Council know what she does and can do for the local community of Blymhill and Weston under Lizard. She already has had dealing s with Bill Hill to help the Village Hall.

She can:

- Help organisations get grants although Vass does this she can assist.
- Work regarding Health and Wellbeing in the community
- Help with Transport the Connect Bus
- Do Health Checks with a qualified person Blood Pressure etc. and discuss people's well-being concerns.
- o Any Age related issues people may have
- Helps with the SSDC GoodLife Website –The Parish Clerk was asked to get some Village Hall information to that Website

Cllr G Carter suggest doing more with the Village Agent such as a monthly Surgery.

Cllr D Maddocks asked Cllr G Carter if he would liaise with Jan Wright to action

that suggestion.

1832 REPORT OF THE COUNTY COUNCILLOR

Cllr M Sutton Reported:

- That there was a new Consultation on the Website
- There is now a Casserole Club in the County basically after some checks volunteers an extra meal once a week or how ever often they want to; and take it
 to someone who is lonely. They are put in touch by the County Council more
 people are required to actually receive meals.

- The County has 3 Pilot Schemes for Asset Based Community Development where local people suggest projects they want done in their area – a report on these will be given in the future.

1833 REPORT OF THE DISTRICT COUNTY COUNCILLORS

Cllr R Wright Reported:

- SSDC now looking after Welfare Benefits such as Respite care for the next 7
 years as part of the care act.
- SSDC have are doing more re-arrangement of their offices to free up office space that they can then rent out to other organizations
- There is a consultation regarding Housing for sites allocated for the Birmingham over spill.
 - Cllr D Maddocks asked if our local plan would be affected as Newport's and Signal's had.
 - Cllr R Wright replied that it would not as there is not the infrastructure for large build.
 - Cllr A Lowe said that those youngsters that live in the community would not have the ability to have new homes in the local villages.
 - Cllr M Sutton said there is the Potential for new green towns and villages –
 like Telford was, but small builds of 30 to 70 homes do not get the
 infrastructure with them due to the cost. Whereas for Hundreds of homes
 there are the economies of scale plus the need for more school places,
 doctors etc.

1834 PLAY AREAS

Cllr G Carter said that he went to the Weston under Lizard play area with Roger Osborne to look at moving the Plaque and has spoken to the Bradford Estate and that will be moved and securely attached to the Cedar Tree there.

1835 **FOOTPATHS AND HIGHWAYS**

- Cllr B Cambidge said that at the Layby on the A5 by the Bradford Arms the HGV
- lorries always park on the pavement not just in the layby itself and that this is affecting that pavement. Cllr M Sutton said that he would look into it.
- Cllr D Maddocks raised the issue that Chapel Lane, by the bottom of Buns Lane had a drain blocked and the road was subsiding – Cllr M Sutton said he would look at it but it may be partly Shropshire County Council as well.
- Cllr M Stokes reported a grid opposite Greenacre Cottage in Brineton the pipework between 2 Gully's were jetted but the workers thought there was a

problem with the pipe also that by Terrace Farm at Terrace Corner Brineton, the grid there was the only one for a quarter of a mile. Cllr M Sutton said he would look at those as well.

Regarding the Traffic Issues for the A5 Cllr M Sutton he shares our thoughts on the matter and reported:

- He had met with Mark Keeling of the Highways Department and the Police Commander. Re the fatality there is still a Police inquiry going on and the Police can make no comments at present.
- Mark Keeling is taking the issues to the Safer Road Partnership.
- Speed measurements were taken in the summer and the average of 12,000 cars was 43 mph.
- 2 more speed measurement projects were still to be carried out.
- Regarding the double white lines these can only be put in place where there is a lack of Vision and on the A5 between Weston and the Bradford Arms the vision is ok – but will look at points where it is not. But not for the whole stretch.
- He cannot get figures from the Safety Vehicles that have the speed Cameras as to how many are caught speeding.
- o Cllr has requested a report from Highways on this issue.

Cllr M Stokes said that the turn to Blymhill from the A5 is also an issue.

Cllr G Carter also said that still not had any action regarding the speed in Weston.

Cllr M Sutton suggested a subcommittee to go through the 2 issues in greater depth – he

would get plans of the A5 and they could document what solutions could be looked at.

RESOLVED A meeting would be held in December and Cllr M Sutton thanked for his help in this matter.
