The Parish Clerk reported that he had received an email from Bill Hill of the Village Hall Committee "We are being pressed by one of the grant providers to give a date when the extension is likely to be completed. I have attached a copy of the total cost of the project and a

not very professional out line of the funds we have. As you can see we have a shortfall. Would the Parish Council consider making a loan of £15,000.00 to the Village Hall committee to be repaid over 10 years with the proviso to pay back earlier if funds allow. This will allow us to get the extension built in the next few months. After some Discussion Cllr D McCowan proposed a loan of £10,000 to be paid back over 10 years and a donation of £5,000. This was seconded by Cllr A Lowe and all present voted in favour.

Resolved: That a loan of £10,000 would be given to the Village Hall Committee to be paid back over 10 years and then a donation of £5,000 be given to them.
